**FROM POINTS NORTH:** Take 95 South to Exit 17 (Elmwood Avenue), Take a LEFT at the stoplight onto Elmwood Avenue, Go to FOURTH traffic light and take a LEFT onto Park Avenue, Follow Park Avenue until you can go no further. Take a RIGHT onto Broad Street, Go ½ mile on Broad Street and you will see a gazebo on your right, take the right building is at the corner.

**FROM POINTS SOUTH:** Take 95 North to Exit 16, Follow exit ramp (stay to the right) to Elmwood Avenue, Bear RIGHT onto Elmwood Avenue, Take LEFT at first intersection onto Park Avenue, Follow Park Avenue until you can go no further, Take a RIGHT onto Broad Street. Go ½ mile on Broad Street and you will see a gazebo on your right, take the right building is at the corner.

**This workshop will give social workers four (4) CE credits.**

**Description:** The focus of this workshop is to understand the theory and principles of Motivational Interviewing and how to utilize it with our clients who have a family member who is using or abusing substances. Motivational Interviewing is an evidence-based clinical method of communication, proven to be effective. After orientation to the underlying spirit, structure and principles of Motivational Interviewing, practical exercises will be utilized to help participants to strengthen empathy skills, recognize, elicit and strengthen "change talk", and roll with conflict.

**Participants will be able to:**

- understand what Motivational Interviewing is as a general set of concepts.
- appreciate how Motivational Interviewing can be used to improve outcomes for family members.
- recognize situations where Motivational Interviewing is useful, as well as situations where it is less useful.
- begin to develop an understanding of theoretical explanations for using Motivational Interviewing with family members.
- appreciate how Motivational Interviewing can work in practice, within a number of different clinical scenarios.



**Stephen R. Andrew, LCSW, LADC, CCS, CGP**, is a storyteller, trainer and the Chief Energizing Officer of Health Education Training Institute. He maintains a compassion-focused private practice in Portland, Maine where he also facilitates a variety of young persons, men's, co-ed, couples and caregiver groups.
